Happy World Thinking Day 2021

On 22nd February 10 million Girl Guides and Girl Scouts will unite to call for and create peace; in their lives and in the world.

What is World Thinking Day?

Celebrated since 1926, World Thinking Day is a day of international friendship. It is an opportunity to speak out on issues that affect young women and to fundraise for 10 million Girl Guides and Girl Scouts in 150 countries.

22nd February was chosen to celebrate World Thinking Day as it was both the birthday of Lord Baden-Powell, founder of the Boy Scout Movement, and Olave Baden-Powell, who was the World Chief Guide.





The theme for World Thinking Day 2021 is Peacebuilding and there are three key elements:

STAND STRONG - understanding peacebuilding and being empowered to be a peacebuilder

STAND UP - exploring conflict, how to resolve it and how to build peace

STAND TOGETHER - taking actions to create a more welcoming and peacebuilding society

On Monday 22nd February Rainbows, Brownies, Guides, Rangers and their leaders will all join together on Zoom to think about being a member of Girlguiding, travel to a Girlguiding World Centre and to have some fun together!
